

# Installation of AfterPay payment module

## 1. Preparatory settings

### Rounding:

Round mode option must be set on the recommended setting (Round up away from 0, when it is half way there). This setting is found at *Preferences->General->Round Mode*.

Round type must be set so prices are rounded on each item. This is the way AfterPay calculates the total value of the cart. Other rounding types can result in errors. This setting is found on *Preferences->General->Round type*.

### Currencies

Currencies must exist for every *merchant* that is to be used.

The currencies supported by AfterPay are SEK, NOK, DKK and EUR. Each currency must be activated and configured to work for each *merchant*, or AfterPays payment option will not be displayed at checkout

### Countries

Those countries that AfterPay is wished to be used on must be activated in PrestaShop.

### Languages

AfterPay's integration has no limitation on languages, but the different payment options will be displayed in the language that is set on the shop. Swedish, Danish, Norwegian and Finish are the supported languages for the payment options. If other languages are chosen, the payment options will be displayed in English.

### Addresses

The addresses for the countries that the integration is built towards work as standard for PrestaShop.

In order to display right payment option for the right country the integration will take into account the currency chosen by the customer as well as the delivery country saved for the customer. The address that will then be used as delivery and invoice address will be retrieved later at checkout (through the social security number for Sweden, mobile number for Norway and postal code and social security number for Finland).

### Payment terms and conditions

The customer has to accept the shop's payment terms and conditions. These

terms and conditions are shown as standard before the different payment option. The payment terms and condition for AfterPay are linked below each payment option. These terms and conditions must be accepted in order to proceed with the payment.

## 2. Installation of the module

### Installation

The module is installed through a click. The module has no overrides. The module will install a table in the database for storing information about an order, such as order number, transaction ID and information about the order status (debited, credited or annulled). When an address is retrieved at checkout it will be saved in the database and deleted as well as the order is successfully processed. Even the addresses of customers that do not proceed with a payment will be deleted, since at every order validation all the addresses added more than 3 days before will be deleted.

The module uses the configuration table for storing all the settings that are saved in the module's configuration page.

The module is installed as a payment module. After installation the module has to be activated for the wished countries and for the wished currencies. Group restrictions can also be set for a payment module. All these settings are found on *Modules/Payment* at PrestaShop's Back Office.

## 3. Settings in the module's configuration

### Where to find it

Under *Modules and Services*->*Modules and Services*, search for AfterPay and choose *Configure*.

The configuration is divided into 5 different parts according to the description below.

### General settings

**Live or Test mode** – The setting switches between development and production environment.

### Google Analytics configuration

Customers that have a Google Analytics ID can insert it here. These ID will be sent to AfterPay when proceeding with an order.

### Configuration for countries

The API Keys are received by AfterPay. An API Key is required for the

integration to work. The Merchant ID is used for linking to the right payment conditions that are shown to the customer at checkout.

### Order Status

Orders that are processed with AfterPay will get a specific order status ('Order Processed with AfterPay').

In order to capture/credit or annul an order, the order status has to be changed in the order page in PrestaShop to the status that is selected in the configuration page, according to the description below:

1. **Capture** – Desired status of an order to make AfterPay debit the order. When this status is chosen for the order, AfterPay will debit the order.
2. **Void/Refund** – Desired status of an order to make AfterPay credit or annul an order. When this status is chosen for the order, AfterPay will credit/annul the order depending on its current status. An order that has not yet been captured will be annulled, an order that has been captured will be credited.

## 4. Testing

Testing information is get from AfterPay. The information is entered in the configuration page and *Test Mode* is switched to *yes*.

## 5. Payment Flow

The module does not replace any standard behaviour in PrestaShop. The payment options that are available for the current cart will be shown under the payment options that are standard in PrestaShop. If those payment alternatives are inactivated, only AfterPays payment options will be shown for the customer.

When the customer clicks on one of the payment alternatives that are shown, the customer must type in personal information for retrieving the correct address. The address will not be shown entirely but will contain asterisks. Together with the address, a link to AfterPay's payment terms and condition is shown. When the payment is processed successfully, the customer will be redirected to a *thank-you* page. The customer will then receive a mail form AfterPay with payment information.

## 6. Uninstall AfterPay module

The module can be uninstalled such as a standard PrestaShop module by clicking on the *Uninstall* button. At uninstallation, the table containing information about the customer/orders will be deleted as well as the values used in configuration.
